<b>Set Aside Name</b>	Blairgowrie & Cameron's Bight

<b>Boundaries</b>	Adjacent the Blairgowrie Yacht Squadron
<b>Agent Managing</b>	Blairgowrie Yacht Squadron

<b>Weather Conditions</b>	Open water exposed to all winds especially N and W winds
<b>Tackle Requirements</b>	<b>Buoys</b> : As specified by an Authorised Mooring Tackle Contractor and must display site identification at all times. Buoys can either be polystyrene or plastic foam filled (minimum of 300mm diameter to a maximum of 500mm). Alternatively a 200mm manufactured stick buoy will be accepted.
	<b>Chain</b> : As specified by an Authorised Mooring Tackle Contractor
	<b>Weights</b> : No ground weights permitted
<b>Tender Arrangements</b>	Tenders (that service larger vessels on swing moorings) that are moored in shallow water or at an approved non-berthing section of a public jetty are required to show the identification of the registered vessel on the tender vessel
<b>Access</b>	Parking available along Pt Nepean Rd
