**Phillip Island Swim Classic, Cowes**

A temporary rule change to the *Marine Act 1988* will prohibit the operation of vessels from 1430 until 1530 on 23 February 2008 in the vicinity of Cowes Jetty for the purpose the Phillip Island Swim Classic.

An exclusion zone will be enforced during this time and includes the waters of Western Port within:

### **Hastings Festival – Victorian Outboard Club Demonstrations**
