The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Wilson's Spit – Shellfish Reef Restoration Works

Date: Thursday 4 May 2017 to Friday 5 May 2017.

Previous Notices: 133(T) – 2017 is referred.

Details: Mariners are advised of shellfish reef restoration works south of Wilson's Spit Channel at approximate location 38°07.122'S, 144°30.403'E (WGS84).

Works will be carried out using a mussel industry punt with davit arm. On-water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with yellow flashing lights from sunset to sunrise in accordance with IALA standards.

During the works divers will operate from a dive support vessel. When divers are operating, the vessel will display a white and blue flag (Alpha) in accordance with international standards.

Mariners are advised to keep 100 metre clearance of the dive support vessel and navigate with caution within the vicinity of the works.
