INSTALLATION & UPGRADE OF NAVIGATION AIDS – NEW BOATING & SWIMMING ZONES

Date: Between 7 February and 22 February 2012.

Details: Mariners are advised of extensive upgrade works to navigation aids along the near shore area from Martha Point, Dromana Bay to 'The Sisters', Sorrento.

The works will include pile driving of new marker piles, removal of redundant piles and buoys and placement of new marker buoys approximately 500m from shore.

The works will be carried out by Elstone Diving Services Pty Ltd.

Marine plant will be operating and diving operations will be required in the general area defined during daylight hours.

All hazards to boating, including floating plant and equipment will be marked with yellow flashing lights from sunset to sunrise as per IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when operating in the area of the works.
