Badger Weir Picnic Ground

Repair works at Badger Weir well underway — January 2019

In October 2018, Parks Victoria commenced major repair works at Badger Weir Picnic Ground. Works are progressing well and are on schedule to be reopened to the public in March 2019. In the meantime, Badger Weir Picnic Ground will continue to remain closed to visitors, allowing works to be undertaken safely.



What works have been done so far?

Since construction began, a number of major upgrades have already been completed by the contractors, including the construction and installation of:

- New signage and fencing throughout the park to ensure the safety of park visitors
- A new staircase to the Weir for safer access
- Re-purposing of the old stone building into a picnic shelter

Works in progress: The final stage of works

Over the next two months, Parks Victoria's contractors are on track to complete the following upgrades at the site:

- Construction of the new toilet block and septic system
- Installation of the new footbridge
- Installing 3 new gas barbecues and one new wood fuel barbecue
- Installing 28 new picnic tables throughout the park
- Repairing all damaged asphalt and stone paths throughout the picnic area
- Repairing all damage to the asphalt access road into the park
- Re-laying new crushed rock surface material throughout all pedestrian areas in the picnic area and carparks for improved access
