Repair Works at Badger Weir Set to Begin

September 2018

This October, Parks Victoria will commence repair works at Badger Weir Picnic Ground. After sustaining significant storm damage in October 2016, Badger Weir Picnic Ground has been closed to the public.

Badger Weir Picnic Ground has already undergone several stages of site clean-up. It is now closer to being open to park visitors and the local community.

Contractor appointed for repairs

After completing a rigorous Tender Review Process, Parks Victoria is excited to announce that a contractor has been successfully selected to undertake the upgrade and repair works at the site.

Reopening Badger Weir

The site's repair and upgrade is expected to take approximately five months. Works are scheduled to commence in October 2018, with an expected completion date of March 2019.

In the meantime, Badger Weir Picnic Ground will remain closed to visitors to allow works to be undertaken promptly and safely.

What will the works include?

Upgrade and repair works at the site will include:

- a new toilet block
- barbeques
- picnic facilities
- a pedestrian bridge
- picnic area borders.

Additionally, the old stone building at the site will be repurposed into an All-Abilities shelter.
