

## **EOI 201705 – Lower Yarra River On-water Food and Beverage Trial**

### **Questions & Answers (25 August 2017)**

- Q Do any of the sites have water, electricity or sewerage services?
- A There are no direct land connections to any services within the proposed licence areas or directly connected to the landings. It is the Licensees responsibility to organise and provide all infrastructure, utilities and services to the on-water business operation including access and installation.
- Q Does Parks Victoria have barges or pontoons for sale or hire for the trial?
- A No. Applicants must make their own enquiries as to the availability of suitable pontoon or barge facilities for the duration of the trial.
- Q Will non-conforming applications be considered?
- A Not as part of this EOI process. Proposals must demonstrate how they meet the objectives and requirements set out in the Invitation for Application Lower Yarra River On-water Food and Beverage Trial document. Unsuccessful applicants may wish to be added to the public land interest register so that they can be notified of future Parks Victoria EOI opportunities.
- Q When will decisions be made and applicants advised of the outcome of the EOI?
- A Parks Victoria will facilitate a panel assessment process following the submission deadline and expects to notify applicants of the outcome by the end of September 2017.
- Q Will Parks Victoria assess proposals based on the highest price bid, or purely determined on the basis of what is proposed?
- A A multi-agency assessment panel will assess applications against the Assessment Criteria outlined on page 8 of the Invitation for Application. Successful applicants will be required to pay the Licence Fee stipulated on page 7 of the Invitation for Application.
